# Umoja Coin Makes Waves as a Single African Currency, Launches Pre-Sale

(February 1, 2023) – The African continent is poised for a major transformation, and cryptocurrencies will play a major role in realizing the vision of 'One People, One Continent, One Currency'. The same vision lies behind the launch of <u>Umoja Coin (UMC)</u>, described as one of the coolest or most promising alt-coins to be launched.

Thus a farmer in Ethiopia or Sudan will be able to send money to a trader in Congo or Kenya with the same currency and with no transaction costs.

The Umoja Coin is based on the globally popular Polygon blockchain, which allows building scalable and user-friendly solutions. The transaction fees are also low, and security is good. The coin is built with an anti-dumping policy, whereby the co-founders' wallets will be locked for 24 months until they get full trading access. The coin is thus not a "get rich quick" scheme.

The inclusive nature of Umoja Coin makes it an empowering force. Today, a large number of Africans can't access banking services. Getting a debit or credit card is just a dream. Cross-border transactions are also ridden with difficulties. A single currency that everyone can use is the answer.

A total of 1.5 billion Umoja Coins (1,500,000,000) will be issued, thus covering the entire predicted population of Africa in 2025. Trading platforms will have a total access to 792,450,000 coins.
